New Video Switching on Integra Receivers

Many of the newest Integra DTR series receivers have a fantastic new feature: up-conversion of composite video and s-video inputs to component (YprPb) format output. This feature is available on the DTR 6.4, 7.4 and 8.4 and allows you to plug all of your video sources into the receiver, regardless of whether they are composite, s-video or component video, and have just one set of component cables going out to your display device.

Normally, any video signal that comes in to your receiver one way must go out the very same way. So, if you have three video sources coming in three different ways (VCR via composite, DSS via s-video and DVD via component video) you would need to have all three types of cables going from the receiver's monitor outputs to your display or television. Not to mention the fact that when you want to switch from one source to another, you would have to switch inputs on both the receiver and the television. This means more system complexity for the operator and more money spent on cables.

The Integra DTR 5.4 will upgrade composite video to s-video, which will simplify things a great deal. But if you go with a DTR 6.4 or higher you will have the best video-switching solution possible.
