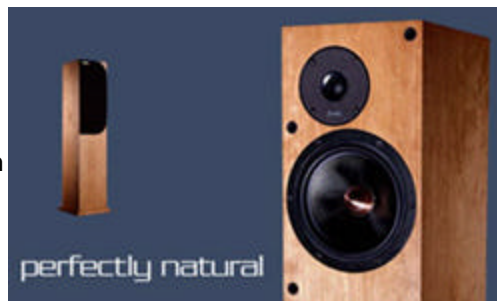

New ProAc Response Series Speakers

After a few weeks of burn-in, the newest ProAc Response models are sounding superb. They look very much like their predecessors on the outside but offer sonic improvements from top to bottom. Specifically, the new models are cleaner sounding and more articulate than before. The drivers show less of their own character and better disappear into the music. They are also more dynamic than ever and have better bass control and power as well. All of the Response models utilize a downward firing bass reflex port, which seems to help bass extension while making room placement even less critical than before.



The changes are due to new driver materials and crossover design. All of the new models have become more efficient than previous ProAc's, making them more compatible with lower-powered, high quality amplification. They sound especially good with the latest Audio Research amplifiers, which are what Stuart Tyler uses in designing and voicing all ProAc models.

While the guts have changed, cabinet dimensions have remained about the same as former versions. The prices are as follows:
